


WASTE MANAGEMENT

COMPOST PITS






As a result, we are reducing the waste burden and at the same time not polluting the soil by using hazardous chemicals as fertilizers

BIOMEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT



The biomedical waste generated is sorted at the source into specific colour coded bins. All the departments take utmost precautions to segregate the biomedical waste and strategic placement of charts regarding the waste disposal protocols aids in the process too. Biomedical waste from various departments is collected at the end of the day by the housekeeping staff and is given to officially authorized agency for its proper disposal

SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT



The sewage water generated in the campus is recycled in the sewage treatment plant and the recycled water generated is used for watering the plants and trees inside the campus.
